


Mothers' Union Ecochamps

The Mothers Union of the Anglican Church in Southern Africa (ACSA) passed a resolution that each Diocese should have an ecochamp. Green Anglicans recently led a 2-day workshop with them, looking at the Biblical basis of care for creation, the

impact of climate on gender and health, how to cater without single use plastic and polystyrene, and how to prepare and respond to climate disasters.

Mothers Union Australia, MUA, worked with Australian Anglican Overseas Aid by contributing funds to a project developing church and community disaster resilience in Tonga and Fiji. This project ended in March 2024 and MUA signed on for a year to help fund "Building Disaster Resilience for People with Disabilities in the Solomon Islands"
