A GENTLE REMINDER WORSHIP AT 9 AM SERVICE


At around 3 minutes before 9 am, a bell will be rung and *we ask for silence in the church after the bell*, as we intentionally prepare to be present to our Lord.

STAMPS FOR ABM


ABM sells used stamps to assist community projects in Australia and overseas. Boxes at All Saints and St Matthews are provided to collect them.
